COURSE DESCRIPTION

The Manitoba Construction Sector Council collaborated with industry partners to develop an Introduction to Project Management course for Indigenous leaders and highly skilled immigrants. The course helps construction managers and company owners address the complex human resource issues that are part of a contemporary workforce. Leading a workforce at a senior level requires project management fundamentals, negotiation, estimating, accounting and quality management.

After completing this course (15 modules) and the course quiz, participants receive a certificate and transcript from the Manitoba Construction Sector Council.

Certificate Completion Requirements	<p>Minimum grade of 75% for course/program quiz</p>
Credit Transfer Opportunities	<p>Learners who successfully complete this course have the potential to receive course credit in the Site Supervisor in Construction Certificate at Red River College or Assiniboine Community College</p>
